

Season Summary

On May 1st of 2012 the Alta Handcrew welcomed back 12 crewmembers from previous seasons and 2 detailers from 2011. The crew promoted 1 lead crewmember to a vacant squad boss position and added 6 new hires to the manifest. The crew completed 97 hours of basic training and completed a base review before going available as a Type 2 IA crew on May 9th at 1600.

Alta completed the Hotshot peer review process in 2012, and is planning on the embedded review in 2013 as the crew continues working toward IHC certification.

The crew was assembled for 178 days and in that time completed 1 week of project work and attended 22 fires throughout the west.

2012 Fires

Alta started the 2012 season in early May on the Pahroc fire in the Great Basin, then responded to a fire in the Rocky Mountain area. Alta then responded to 6 fires in the Southwest area in May and June. The remainder of Alta's 2012 season was spent on 14 fires in the Great Basin area; finishing up on the Thompson Creek fire in late October.
